HOW TO GET THERE

October 2017 Monthly Party:

MOUNTAIN VIEW MASONIC HALL, 890 Church Street, Mountain View, CA 94041

DIRECTIONS: From 280: exit at South El Monte Avenue, to Foothill Expressway. Right on Foothill Expressway, left on Miramonte Avenue, across El Camino Real West, to South Shoreline Blvd. Turn right onto Church Street.

From 101 North: Exit at Moffett Blvd. Follow Moffett Blvd. south to Central Expressway. Cross Central Expressway onto Castro Street. Turn right onto Church Street (5 blocks).

From 101 South: Exit at North Shoreline Boulevard and turn right. Follow North Shoreline, turn left onto Church Street.

Park in the lot behind the building, accessed from Franklin Street, or on neighborhood streets.

November 2017 Monthly Party:

ARLINGTON COMMUNITY CHURCH, 52 Arlington Avenue, Kensington, CA 94707

DIRECTIONS: From Highway 80, exit on Buchanan Street, head toward the hills. Buchanan turns into Marin Avenue. Take Marin to the "circle," go about 270 degrees around and take Arlington Ave. The church is in 1.9 miles, on the left. Or take Moeser Lane up from San Pablo Ave. in El Cerito to Arlington Ave. and turn right. There is a parking lot across the street.

December 2017 Monthly Party:

HILL AND VALLEY CLUB, 1808 B Street, Hayward, CA 94541

DIRECTIONS: From the West: Take 580 East, exit at Grove Way. Turn right on Grove Way, then first left onto Center Street. Center Street bears right and becomes B Street. The hall will be on your right.

From the West (via the San Mateo Bridge): Take CA-92 East. Continue onto Foothill Blvd. (also named Jackson Street). Turn right onto B Street. The hall will be on your left.

From the East: Take 580 West and exit at Castro Valley. Turn left onto Castro Valley Blvd., then left on Grove Way, then left onto Center Street. Center Street bears right and becomes B Street. The hall will be on the right.
