# How To Get There

## April Monthly Party • 3:00 PM

Aptos Grange, 2555 Mar Vista Drive, Aptos 95003

**DIRECTIONS:** From the North: From Route 1 south in Santa Cruz take exit 436 for Park Avenue in Capitola. Turn left under the freeway (signs for Cabrillo College). From the South: take exit 436 and turn right on Park Avenue. From Park, turn right on Soquel Drive and go east 1 1/4 miles. Turn right at Mar Vista Drive (small street sign). The hall will be on the right towards the end of Mar Vista Drive. There is plenty of parking available at the Grange.

## May Monthly Party • 7:30 PM

Mountain View Masonic Lodge, 890 Church Street, Mountain View 94041

**DIRECTIONS:** From 280: exit at S. El Monte Avenue, Continue on El Monte to Rt. 82 (El Camino Real). Right on El Camino Real and get in the left lane. Left turn onto S. Shoreline Blvd. Turn right onto Church Street. From 101 North: Exit at Moffett Blvd. Follow Moffett Blvd. south to Central Expressway. Cross Central Expressway on to Castro Street. Turn right onto Church Street (5 blocks). From 101 South: Exit at North Shoreline Boulevard and turn right. Follow North Shoreline; turn left onto Church Street. The Lodge is on the corner of Church and Franklin Streets.

Park in the lot behind the building, accessed from Franklin Street, or on neighborhood streets.

## June Monthly Party • 7:30 PM

Hill and Valley Club, 1808 B Street, Hayward 94541

**DIRECTIONS:** From the West: Take 580 East, exit at Grove Way. Turn right on Grove Way, then first left onto Center Street. Center Street bears right and becomes B Street. The hall will be on your right. From the West (via the San Mateo Bridge): Take CA-92 East. Continue onto Foothill Blvd. (also named Jackson Street). Turn right onto B Street. The hall will be on your left. From the East: Take 580 West and exit at Castro Valley. Turn left onto Castro Valley Blvd., then left on Grove Way, then left onto Center Street. Center Street bears right and becomes B Street. The hall will be on the right at the corner of B and Linden Streets. Parking accessed from Linden St.
