Our Charlene

40 bar reel for 3 couples in a longwise set

1-8 1s $\frac{1}{2}$ turn with right hands to face each other in the center and cast ($\frac{1}{2}$ turn and twirl) to second place on opposite sides as 2s step up on bars 5 and 6, and turn right hand $\frac{3}{4}$ to face 3rd man, ready for Alternating Tandem Reel of Three (dolphin reel) on 2nd corner diagonal.

9-16 1st lady leading and giving right shoulder, 1s dance Alternating Tandem Reel of Three on 2nd corner diagonal; end back-to-back in the middle facing opposite sides.

17-24 (Modified Inverted Double Triangles) 2s + 1s + 3s set in as in Double Triangles, 1s Pas-de-Basque out and turn right about to face in, while 2s and 3s Pas-de-Basque in and turn right about to face out, 2s + 1s + 3s set, 2s and 3s Pas-de-Basque out while 1s set advancing with 1st man pulling back left shoulder to end facing 3rd lady, 1st lady behind him.

25-32 1st man leading and giving left shoulder, 1s dance Alternating Tandem Reel of Three on 1st corner diagonal; end side by side in the middle on opposite sides.

33-40 1s dance down the middle, woman turn under man's right arm in front of partner to change to own sides, and dance back up to end in 2nd place.

Traditionally, each San Francisco Solstice Party program includes a dance devised by or for a class member.
